

INDUSTRIAL SAFETY

- COURSE:** Forklift Training and Certification
- DESCRIPTION:** This safety course is designed to certify all operators of Powered Industrial Trucks for three years – per OSHA 29 CFR 1910.178. This program is also intended to reduce the number of injuries and deaths that occur as a result of inadequate training

- AUDIENCE:** All employees who operate Powered Industrial Trucks (Forklift).
OSHA defines a Powered Industrial Truck as: *any mobile, powered propelled truck used to carry, push, pull, lift, stack or tier materials.*
- OBJECTIVE:** This training program will certify operators of Powered Industrial Trucks with a three year certification and permit per OSHA 29 CFR 1910.178.
